Pope Francis



Paul VI invited us to deepen the call to renewal and to make it clear that renewal does not only concern individuals but the entire Church. Let us return to a memorable text which continues to challenge us. "The Church must look with penetrating eyes within herself, ponder the mystery of her own being... This vivid and lively self-awareness inevitably leads to a comparison between the ideal image of the Church as Christ envisaged her and loved her as his holy and spotless bride, and the actual image which the Church presents to the world today... This is the source of the Church's heroic and impatient struggle for renewal: the struggle to correct those flaws introduced by her members which her own self-examination, mirroring her exemplar, Christ, points out to her and condemns". The Second Vatican Council presented ecclesial conversion as openness to a constant self-renewal born of fidelity to Jesus Christ: "Every renewal of the Church essentially consists in an increase of fidelity to her own calling... Christ summons the Church as she goes her pilgrim way... to that continual reformation of which she always has need, in so far as she is a human institution here on earth". There are ecclesial structures which can hamper efforts at evangelization, yet even good structures are only helpful when there is a life constantly driving, sustaining and assessing them. Without new life and an authentic evangelical spirit, without the Church's "fidelity to her own calling", any new structure will soon prove ineffective.

Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Run

The Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose has been a Knights of Columbus tradition for 57 years. In 1960, groups of Columbian Squires in Mexico, Canada and the United States decided to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe by carrying a rose across North America from Canada to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico and then presented the Rose to her on her feast day, December 12th. In 2001 the Knights reaffirmed the Run by recognizing the sacredness of life and Mary's position as the Mother of God and our Mother.

We are now into the 57th running of the Silver Rose, and the fourth year for Wisconsin Knights. There are six Silver Roses and Wisconsin is part of Route 3. The Rose arrived in Wisconsin from Iowa Knights on the 16th of July. The Rose will be passed to Illinois Knights on August 13th after the Rose has traveled throughout the State of Wisconsin with 31 locations having special prayer services. Knights will present all six of the Silver Roses to Mary on December 12th at the Basilica in Monterrey.

Every stop along the route of the Silver Rose Pilgrimage is an occasion for prayer and spiritual renewal centered on the rosary. English and Spanish booklets containing recommended prayers, scripture readings and a litany accompany the Silver Rose. The Rose will pass through Beloit on August 12th for you to place your thanks and your petitions for Mary!! Our local service will be at St. Jude Church at 2 pm with Fr. John presiding. 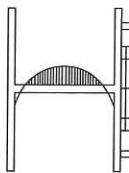
