## Pope Francis



**Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the Earth.**

Meekness is yet another expression of the interior poverty of those who put their trust in God alone. Indeed, in the Bible the same word – anawim – usually refers both to the poor and to the meek. Someone might object: “If I am that meek, they will think that I am an idiot, a fool or a weakling”. At times they may, but so be it. It is always better to be meek, for then our deepest desires will be fulfilled. The meek “shall inherit the earth”, for they will see God’s promises accomplished in their lives. In every situation, the meek put their hope in the Lord, and those who hope for him shall possess the land... and enjoy the fullness of peace. For his part, the Lord trusts in them: “This is the one to whom I will look, to the humble and contrite in spirit, who trembles at my word”.

Es mejor ser siempre mansos, y se cumplirán nuestros mayores anhelos: los mansos «poseerán la tierra», es decir, verán cumplidas en sus vidas las promesas de Dios. Porque los mansos, más allá de lo que digan las circunstancias, esperan en el Señor, y los que esperan en el Señor poseerán la tierra y gozarán de inmensa paz. Al mismo tiempo, el Señor confía en ellos: «En ese pondré mis ojos, en el humilde y el abatido, que se estremece ante mis palabras».
